







Non-burnable Waste Collection Day / Recyclable Waste Collection Day	Designated refuse bags	<b>Burnable Waste</b>	<p>○Food Waste (leftovers, shells, etc.) ○Paper Products (diapers, scrap and shredded paper, etc.) ○Vegetation (small branches, flowers, etc.) ○Textiles (clothing, etc.) ○Leather&amp;Rubber Products (bags, shoes, boots, etc.) ○Non-recyclable Plastic (CDs, straws, toothbrushes, etc.) ○Pet Waste, litter Sand, etc.</p>	<p>◎Make sure to thoroughly drain excess water from food waste. ◎Cut rubber hoses, ropes, and other long items longer than 50 cm into pieces of 50 cm or less before disposal</p>
		<b>Non-burnable Waste</b>	<p>○Ceramics&amp;Glass Products (dishes, cups, flower pots, etc.) ○Home Appliances ○Metals (Cooking pots, kettles, knives, etc.)</p> <p>◎Wrap broken glass and sharp objects in paper, label the object clearly before put them in the designated bag.</p>	<p>○Small electronic appliances (mobile phones, irons, hair dryers, game consoles, etc.) should be placed in collection box at Town office or Culture Exchange center (size 20 cm by 30 cm). If they cannot fit in, they should be disposed of as non-burnable waste.</p>
		<b>Oversize Waste</b>	<p>○Items that cannot fit into designated bags such as tables, dressers, futons, mattresses, sofas, chairs, beds, carpets, storage boxes, bicycles, gas stoves, heaters, bookshelves, etc.</p>	<p>◎Items that cannot fit into designated bags should be classified as "Oversize waste" ◎Items that fall under home appliance recycling (such as televisions, refrigerators/freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers, and air conditioners) or computer recycling cannot be disposed of in this way.</p>
	Place an "Oversize waste" sticker	<b>Hazardous Waste</b>	<p>○Batteries ○Lighters ○Mercury Thermometers ○Fluorescent lamps ○Spray Cans /Gas Canisters ○Video&amp;Cassette Tapes</p> <p>Make sure to puncture spray cans</p>	<p>◎ If spray cans or gas canisters still contain gas, they may cause explosions. Make sure to completely use them up and puncture used cans. ◎ To prevent fluorescent tubes from breaking, place them in the original case when disposal</p>
		<b>Cans</b>	<p>○Beer and Juice Cans ○Cans for Canned Food, Snacks, Seaweed, and Powdered Milk</p> <p>※Do not squash</p>	<p>◎Make sure to rinse thoroughly. ◎Do not squash ◎Do not put cigarette butts inside</p>
		<b>Bottles</b>	<p>○Bottles for juice, alcohol, seasonings ○Cosmetic bottles</p> <p>◎Make sure to remove the cap • Plastic cap → Plastic packaging &amp; wrappings • Paper cap → Paper packaging • Cork → Burnable waste • Aluminum/steel cap → Non-burnable waste</p>	<p>◎Make sure to rinse thoroughly. ◎Return beer and sake bottles to the store if possible</p>
		<b>PET Bottles</b>	<p>○PET bottles for juice, tea, shochu, etc. ○Caps and labels are Plastic packaging&amp;wrappings</p> <p>※Do not squash</p>	<p>○Caps and labels are Plastic packaging&amp;wrappings ◎Make sure to rinse all bottles</p>
		<b>Polystyrene Food tray, boxes &amp; packaging</b>	<p>White polystyrene food trays, white polystyrene boxes and packaging</p>	<p>◎Rinse if dirty or soiled ◎Make ure to remove any paper labels or stickers ✖Colored foams and strays are "Plastic packaging&amp;wrappings"</p>
		<b>Plastic packaging &amp; wrappings</b>	<p>○Plastic bags for snacks, instant noodles, plastic wrapping ○Bottles of shampoo, detergents, cooking oil etc ○Plastic egg boxes ○Convenience lunch box, prepared food, colored trays, etc. ○Labels, caps of PET bottles</p> <p>Plastic made but be sorted as Burnable waste</p> <p>Plastic tupperware Straws Plastic bucket wash bowl Plastic toys</p>	<p>◎Rinse if dirty or soiled. There is no need to clean with soap. ◎If it is still too dirty after rinsing, it should be sorted as "burnable waste" ◎Plastic products that are neither containers nor packaging, such as CDs, toothbrushes, straws, video/cassette tape cases, are "burnable waste"</p> <p>※Check for this mark</p>
		<b>Paper packaging</b>	<p>○Paper boxes for tissues, snacks, detergent, etc ○Paper cups for yogurt, ice cream, etc ○Paper bags ○Paper cartons for sake or condiment, whose interiors are processed with foil</p>	<p>◎Rinse food and drink paper packs lightly</p> <p>※Check for this mark</p>
		<b>Paper cartons</b>	<p>○Milk and drinking yogurt paper cartons, those are not line with foil.</p> <p>◎Put them out on clear waste collection days. ✖Paper cartons whose interiors are processed with foil are "Paper packaging"</p>	<p>①Rinse ②Cut open, dry ③Tie down</p>
